

Boards & Commissions Guide

1  Preview the various boards and commissions advertised that have vacancies.

2  If you are interested in serving on a certain board, please complete the online application [HERE](#).

3  Your application will be presented to the WSAC Board of Directors, and once a decision has been made by the Board, a member of the WSAC staff will notify you of the status of your application and any next steps (if applicable).

4  If you are chosen by the WSAC Board to continue in the nomination process, your name will be submitted to the governing body of the particular Board or Commission for their final decision. (This could take anywhere from a few weeks to a few months, so we appreciate your patience and understanding).

5  You may be required to submit a 2nd application to the Governor's office, which requires more information if you are selected to serve on a certain board or commission that the Governor has appointment authority on.

6  Once a final appointment decision has been made, you will be notified of the outcome.

PLEASE NOTE

If you have completed an application with the Governor's office through their online portal, you will still need to submit an application with WSAC and inform us of which board or commission you applied for, so we can help keep track of your application status. It is preferred that you first apply with WSAC so we can help guide you through the application process.
